### Glasgow Coma Scale

<b>Eyes opening</b>	Spontaneously	4

The GCS is usually reported by giving the scores in each of the 3 individual fields as well as the overall score. For example a patient who opens his eyes to pain, make incomprehensible noises and moves his hand to the painful stimuli would have a GCS 9, E2 V2 M5.
